In the earliest times, children got their education directly from parents and other adults.

They learned mainly skills for survival. Adults passed down this knowledge through spoken language. Eventually, cultures around the world began inventing writing. As societies developed **they** set up schools to teach reading, writing, maths, and other subjects.

The first schools were usually just for boys. Most of the students came from rich and powerful families. Often the purpose of their education was religious training. In many cultures, the religious leaders formed the highest level of society. Some schools had other purposes as well. Many schools focused on military training.
