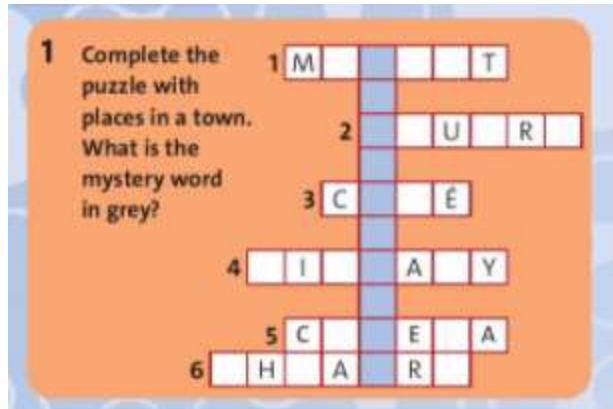

Is there a ... on your map? Yes, there is.

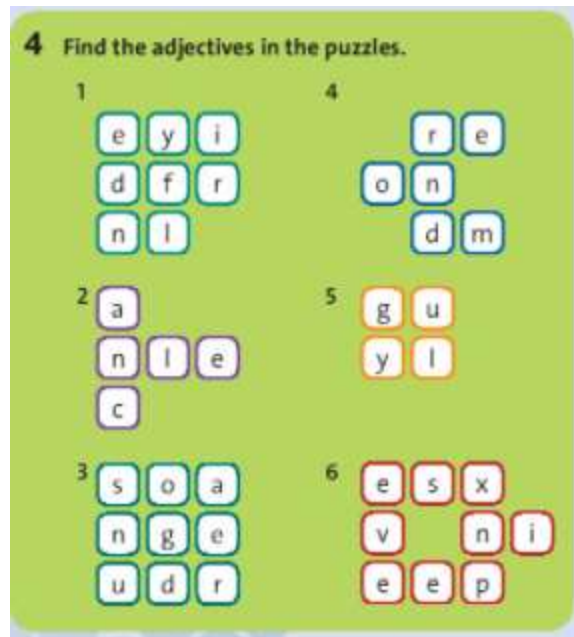
